## **CALL FOR PARTICIPATION**

The Third World Conference on the History of Computing and Education (HCE3) is a co-located conference within the 2008 World Computer Congress (WCC) of the International Federation for Information Processing (IFIP). The IFIP Working Group 9.7 on the History of Computing and the IFIP Technical Committee 3 (TC3) on Education are sponsoring the event. The conference will take place as part of WCC in Milan, Italy, 2008 September 7-10.

# PURPOSE

Although computing is a modern phenomenon, it is important to capture its evolution as it once occurred around the world. This HCE3 conference underscores the importance of recording the historical events as they had developed in different countries. The conference program committee will consider papers that are purely historical in nature, or historical papers related to education. Dependent upon location, elements of the integration of computing technology and education appear as far back as the 1960s – and even the 1950s. Therefore, in an effort to preserve this historical evolution, the HCE3 conference program committee welcomes contributions to document how computing evolved over time or how computing has interacted with the educational processes from those early days. Hence, the purpose of this conference is to bring forward computing history to the global community through analysis and interpretation of the past. Perhaps the experiences of the past, both positive and negative, may be useful for future generations. The temporal scope of this event should cover the early days through the mid-1990s.

## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

### Papers

All authors must submit electronically in Microsoft Word format papers not exceeding 4000 words by email to the Program Committee Chair at the address <John.Impagliazzo@Hofstra.edu>. The name, affiliation, and email address of all authors must appear in the paper and the contact information for the lead author should appear on a cover page. Papers should be submitted following the norms of the official publisher Springer Science+Business Media, IFIP Series. Authors of panel and poster must submit proposals electronically in Microsoft Word format papers and not exceeding 500 words by email to the Program Committee Chair at the address <John.Impagliazzo@Hofstra.edu>. Information required is similar to papers. Proposals should follow the norms of the official publisher Springer Science+Business Media, IFIP Series. Panel sessions should be provoking, present different points of view, and encourage debate. Posters should reflect and illustrate work-in-progress related to the theme of the conference.
